

Eligibility and Rules

1. All sections of the entry form must be legible, complete, signed, and reflect accurate information. Please make a copy for your records.
2. The Registration Tag must be retained and affixed to the back bottom right of your entry.
3. No substitution of artwork allowed.
4. All artists must be 16 years old by *October 1, 2011*.
5. All entries must be originals. No reproductions. No works that copy all or a part of another artist's work.
6. This is a non-juried show therefore you will not receive a confirmation; acceptance in the show is assumed. However, due to limited display space, acceptance of entries may be determined by date received.
7. Works on canvas must be framed. If the depth of the canvas is 1¼ inches or more the work may be painted on all four edges instead of framed
8. All framed entries must include a hanging wire. Wires cannot extend beyond the upper frame edge. No sawtooth hangers or clip frames
9. Artwork larger than 16" x 20" and requiring protective clear covering must use Acrylic (*Plexiglass*) glazing.
10. No artwork shall exceed 4 feet in any one direction.
11. Sculptures exceeding 75 lbs. require the artist to setup and move.
12. No sale price may exceed \$1,000.

Patrons will be asked to make their checks out to ECAA. Artist will receive a check from the ECAA less a 15% handling fee following the close of the show.

Entry Categories

ECAA members may enter 3 entries per category.
Non members may enter 2 entries per category.

1. Oil

Any 2-dimensional surface painted only with traditional oil paint or water-based oil. Alkyd paint acceptable.

2. Acrylic

Any 2-dimensional surface painted only with acrylic paint.

3. Watercolor

Any 2-dimensional surface painted only with watercolor.
China white and pen and ink accents are acceptable.

4. Pastel

Works completed in chalk, soft or oil pastels.

Photography (2 categories)

5. Black and White

Film or digital. If digital, no Photoshop-like filters or distortion can be used.

6. Color

Film or digital. If digital, no Photoshop-like filters or distortion can be used.

7. Digital Art

Computer-manipulated art work.

8. Sculptural Forms

All 3-dimensional objects. May be made from metal, wood, paper, clay, found objects, Styrofoam, resin, stone, including origami. Please no jewelry.

9. Mixed Media/Collage

If it doesn't fit anywhere else, uses multiple mediums or is a collage, then your art belongs here.

10. Drawing Media

Works may be completed in pencil, colored pencil, pen and ink, or pen and ink with wash (if mostly pen and ink)

11. Printmaking

Relief, intaglio, silkscreen, monotypes, mono-prints, etc.

12. Special category limited to 1 entry per artist

"Let's see what that sounds like."

Entry must clearly illustrate the theme and may be in any medium.

Bin Sales \$5 per artist Sell your unframed art!

Once again we will offer the sale of your unframed art on Saturday and Sunday.

Bin Sale Art Rules:

- members only
 - limit of 5 items, original or reproduction okay
 - not to exceed 3/8" thick
 - not more than 30" high or wide
 - clear protective covering required
 - sticker with artist's name & price in the upper right hand corner
- *optional: title, medium

Drop-off and pick-up of Bin Sale items is scheduled for the same time as art show entries. To participate in the Bin sales you may pay \$5 now to reserve your spot or pay at check-in. However, due to space available acceptance of bin items on Sept. 29 may be limited.

Whether you have 1 or 5 bin items the Price is \$5.

You must be a member to place items in the Bin Sales, you do not have to enter the show to participate in the bin sales.
